# War, Warming, and our Addiction to Oil

## The Iraq War and Global Warming have one clear thing in common: OIL. BIG OIL.

Burning oil and gas is responsible for more than a third of global greenhouse gas emissions; the military is the largest single consumer of petroleum in the USA – which is, in turn, the largest consumer of petroleum in the world.

The oil industry has systematically funded efforts to discredit legitimate climate science and obstruct international negotiations for more than a decade.

Big Oil's legislators and lobbyists continue to block meaningful action on clean energy alternatives at every opportunity, just as they continue to fail to stop the war.

Right now, Big Oil's lobbyists and the Bush administration are pushing the proposed Iraqi Oil Law, to open Iraq's oil fields to control by foreign corporations like Exxon and Chevron.

Politicians of both parties get campaign contributions from Big Oil, \$11 million on the 2004 elections alone. In return, Big Oil has gotten subsidies and support from our Congressmen using our tax money – to the tune of \$32 billion dollars over five years. That's a return on investment of nearly 60:1!

The first step in ending our collective addiction to oil is reducing oil's influence over our politicians and demanding political independence from Big Oil. While Congress is taking some important steps now, they are limited and unlikely to become law.

## America needs an Oil Change.

The dirty oil money gumming up our political system must be removed. Once its gone, the possibilities for a sound economy, clean energy, peace, and real security will be much brighter. It's time to ensure that our representatives represent us, not the oil companies.
